Water Powered Sawmill with Wooden Gears at Kings Landing

Kings Landing Historical Settlement, just off the Trans-Canada Highway 23 miles west of Fredericton on the banks of the St. John River is a recreation of a nineteenth-century New Brunswick village. The St. John River and its tributaries provided the necessary waterpower to operate sawmills and grist mills. Kings Landing Sawmill, operational today, offers a look at 1830s technology. Its saw cuts a foot a minute, so it would take about three-quarters of an hour to saw a full-sized tree. *Watch Video*

Recent action by the Forest Stewardship Council® (FSC) to suspend a major charcoal producer in Europe is one outcome of the FSC and Forest Products Laboratory (FPL) partnership. Wiedenhoeft, Research Botanist and Team Leader in FPL's Center for Wood Anatomy Research (CWAR), has led the CWAR side of a multi-year, award-winning research cooperation between FSC and FPL. Take a Look at How Quickly a Forest Can Recover From Fire

On April 22, a spring wildfire roared through Penn State Forest in the New Jersey Pine Barrens, sending 100-foot flames shooting from the crowns of the pitch pines. The fire consumed half a square mile in 40 minutes and could be seen from space. By the time the New Jersey Forest Fire Service got it under control, it had burned 843 acres, an area the size of Central Park. *Read More*

Visiting Woodchips Embedded Links to Webpages

Hyperlinks embedded into Woodchips allow readers to enjoy featured video or audio presentations as well full news articles or papers of interest with just a simple click of their mouse. The links appear at the end of an article (a news headline with one or two introductory sentences) typically as *Watch Video*, *Read More*, or *For More Information*.

To open the link, place your cursor over <u>Watch Video</u> or <u>Read More</u> and so on, and then left click on your mouse. That should open the link in a new window providing access to the specifically linked webpage.

With this issue of Woodchips, we will start listing the full URL to each hyperlink on a second page. If needed, the URL can be copied and pasted into your web browser address bar (also known as location bar or URL bar).
