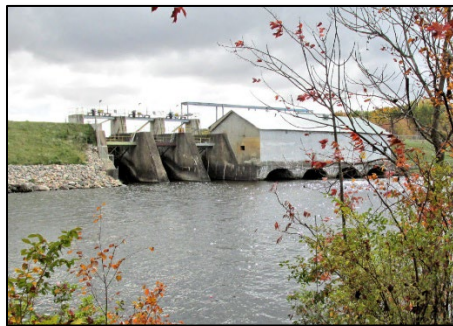


Conference Lodging
